Cutting Corrections for Homecoming:

Corrections are for the **Fabric B 1** $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and the **Fabric C 4** $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips on page 2. (One of each strip will be eliminated and replaced by a 1 $\frac{1}{8}$ " strip and a 4 $\frac{1}{8}$ ", respectively.)

Fabric B - 1¹/₂" strips.

- <u>Cut 4</u>, not 5 as originally stated. Make all the same subcuts, except cut only <u>2</u> 1¹/₂" x 5⁷/₈" pieces. (This was originally stated as 7 pieces.)
- <u>Also cut a new</u> **1**⁷/₈" **strip**. Subcut 5 1⁷/₈" x 5⁷/₈" pieces.

Fabric C - 4¹/₂" strips.


- <u>Cut 3</u>, not 4 as originally stated. Make the same 4¹/₂" x 5¹/₂" subcuts, the same 4¹/₂" x 10¹/₂" subcuts but cut only <u>5</u> 4¹/₂" x 5⁷/₈" pieces. (This was originally stated as 7 pieces.) Eliminate the 4¹/₂" x 11¹/₂" piece and the 4¹/₂" x 15¹/₂" piece. (You will cut them from the new 4⁷/₈" strip.)
- <u>Also cut a new</u> **4**⁷/₈" **strip**. Subcut 2 4⁷/₈" x 5⁷/₈" rectangles. <u>Trim the strip to 4¹/₂</u>" and then cut the one 4¹/₂" x 11¹/₂" piece and the one 4¹/₂" x 15¹/₂" piece.

Corrections for "Sewing the HST+SB's and the HST+LB's":

Corrections are required for Step 1, 2 and 3 instructions on page 8.


 Place a <u>Fabric B 1¹/₂" x 5⁷/₈" piece</u> right sides together with a <u>Fabric C 4⁷/₈" x 5⁷/₈" rectangle</u>. They should be aligned along a 5⁷/₈" edge. Sew together with a ¹/₄" seam. Sew the seam again, slightly inside the other to reinforce the stitching. Press flat to set the seam and then press seam in one direction. Repeat twice. The units will be 5⁷/₈" square.

1.1 On one unit, draw a line diagonally from the **top left** corner to the opposite corner (bottom right). On the other unit draw a line diagonally from the **top right** corner to the opposite corner (bottom left). <u>You need the top triangle of each of these.</u>



2. Place a <u>Fabric B 1⁷/₈" x 5⁷/₈" piece</u> right sides together with a <u>Fabric C 4¹/₂" x 5⁷/₈" rectangle</u>. They should be aligned along a 5⁷/₈" edge. Sew together with a ¹/₄" seam. Sew the seam again, slightly inside the other to reinforce the stitching. Press flat to set the seam and then press seam in one direction. Repeat 5 times. The units will be 5⁷/₈" square.

2.1 On three units, draw a line diagonally from the *top left* corner to the opposite corner (bottom right). On two units draw a line diagonally from the *top right* corner to the opposite corner (bottom left). <u>You need the bottom triangle of each of these.</u>



3. Continue with the Step 4 and on, unchanged.
